The theory contribution of case study research designs

Only few papers have compared case study research designs so far In all of these comparisons, the number of designs differs as well as the issues under consideration In an early debate between Dyer and Wilkins (1991) and Eisenhardt (1991), Dyer and Wilkins compared the case study research design by Eisenhardt (1989)
