The Informal Reading Inventory (IRI) is an individually-administered diagnostic tool that assesses a student's reading comprehension and reading accuracy. The IRI measures three reading levels: independent, instructional and frustrational. The independent reading level is the level at which a student reads without help from the teacher.

Informal Assessments for Reading Development help teachers to use their observations to be responsive and identify needs, form flexible groups, prompt for support, and notice characteristics of readers over time.

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Informal Assessments for Reading Development

In kindergarten, perform the Informal Reading Inventory at least twice per year, at mid-year and at the end of school. In first and second grades, it should be done at least three times, at the beginning of the school year, at mid-year, and at the end of the year.

Roe and Burns Informal Reading Inventory This assessment measures word recognition (accuracy), rate and comprehension in oral passage reading. "A" passages are for pre-testing; "B" passages are for post testing. Begin the pretest with the pre-primer (PP) passage from the "A" set.
