However, the most typical external microwave oven dimensions are from 29 to 30 inches wide, a height of 16 to 18 inches, and a depth of 15 to 16 inches. The most common microwave oven size is between 1.5 and 2.2 cubic feet of internal capacity.

### What are the Different Sizes of Microwave Ovens?

The weight of a new microwave depends on its dimensions. Compact up to 1 cubic feet capacity (29.3 liters) typically will be in a range between 32 – 39 pounds or 14.5 – 17.7 kilograms. Wider and higher products might be a few times heavier and 30” build-in microwaves might weight up to 100 lb (45.4 kg.) or even more.

Because they need to fit into the space above a standard cooktop, over-the-range microwaves offer less variation than countertop models in terms of size. Most models have a width of between 29 and 30 inches, a depth of between 15 and 16 inches, and a height of between 16 and 18 inches.
