A tow dolly requires regular maintenance and repairs on the tires, wheels, and frame. Two sets of safety cables are required — 1 to secure the motorhome to the tow dolly, and 1 to secure the tow dolly to the vehicle. (Tie-down straps frequently fall on tow dollies.)
